
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Yellowstone Fall Backcountry Ride Sept 3-9, 2006 \$1900

Sept 3: Arrive Bozeman or Gardiner, Montana. Gardiner is the northern Gateway to Yellowstone National Park. Overnight in local motel. Outfitter and Boojum staff will meet group at motel in late afternoon for trip orientation.

Sept 4: Early morning departure by van from motel to trailhead in Yellowstone National Park. Pack up and begin ride to first night's camp.





Sept 5: Layover day at same camp with optional day-long ride, fishing and hiking.

Sept 6: Pack up and ride to new camp.


Sept 7 & 8: Layover days at same camp with optional day rides, fishing and hiking.

Sept 9: Last day's ride out to trailhead. Transfer to Gardiner or Bozeman depending on arrangements.

Boojum's early Fall Yellowstone ride is a combination of riding, wildlife, and spectacular scenery. Be sure to bring your rod and reel if you enjoy fishing. This is the time of year when we have the best chance of seeing elk and hearing the bull elk bugle. We may also spot moose and deer and, if we're lucky, we'll catch a glimpse of a bear or wolf. September is the transitional time of year for weather in Montana and Wyoming. As



such, we have to be prepared for sunny, warm days as well as snowy conditions with cold nights. Our Clothing & Gear list reflects the rapidly changing weather at this time of year. Two-person tents are provided.



Head guide and horse wrangler H.A. Moore will lead our pack trip in the northwest corner of the Park, referred to as 'Cowboy Heaven'. H.A. has been a licensed guide and outfitter in Yellowstone's backcountry for over 25 years. He provides first-rate horses and stock, top-notch wranglers, and we are delighted

to be working with him again this year.



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What's included: Meals begin with breakfast on Sept 4th and end with lunch on Sept 9th. Transportation to and from Yellowstone National Park, horses and tack, guides, tents and group camping gear is included.

What's not included: Meals and overnight motel accommodations on Sept 3rd. We will be happy to make reservations for you at a local hotel, with convenient walking access to restaurants, grocery stores and shops.

Departures: If you plan to depart Bozeman on Sept 9th, please do not schedule your flight earlier than 7:00PM. While we strive to be back in Bozeman by 5:00PM on the last day, there are many factors that can delay our ride out of the Park and subsequent transfer back to Bozeman.
